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CONDITIONS OF PLAY

These conditions are general across all Championship events played by the Half Moon Bay Golf Club. The different formats of games require more definition.

Open Format

The format for the HMB Open will be stroke and played over two rounds unless the Match and Tournament Committee decides that due to serious and extenuating circumstances, including, but not limited to, incidents such as severe weather conditions, the Championship be played over fewer rounds.

The Championships will be divided into three Grades for Men and two Grades for Ladies, A Grade up to 9.4, B Grade 9.5 to 17.4, and C Grade 17.5 to 54.4 for Men Ladies Division (1) up to 20.4 & Division (2) 20.5 to 54.4. The handicap limits of each Grade will be decided by the Match and Tournament Committee prior to the Championships commencing.

Handicaps:

Players must play off the handicap to which they are entitled on the day of the first round of the Open and continue to play off that handicap for subsequent rounds of the HMB Open.

Men's A Grade: up to 9.4

Men's B Grade: 9.5 to 17.4

Men's C Grade: 17.5 to 54.4

Ladies Division 1: up to 20.4

Ladies Division 2: 20.5 to 54.4

Your GA Handicap will decide your division, but you will play off your daily handicap for the event. Handicaps will be frozen from day 1.

Draws:

The Match & Tournament Committee has the discretion to include players in a draw or move players within the timesheet for whatever reason.

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DECIDING TIES IN RAY HOWARTH MEMORIAL OPEN:

1. **In the event of a tie, a sudden death playoff on Hole 18 or determined by the Match & Tournament Committee will be played over until a winner is decided. The Runner Up is determined by counting back the gross scores from the Championship starting with the last 18 holes played and using the standard count back procedure.**
2. Players **MUST** be ready to play at their scheduled starting time unless expressly notified otherwise by the starter. All players must register their presence at the golf shop at least 20 minutes before their scheduled tee time.
3. It is the responsibility of the players to be at the Clubhouse and available for a playoff.
4. A **referee** will be assigned to each playoff. This person has the **authority of the Golf Committee** to take **priority** on any tee over other Championship players, other competition players or public players, **in order that the playoff can be completed expeditiously.**
5. In the event of a tie for the Nett Winners or Runner Up, it will be decided by a count back. The first count back decision will be the best nett score for the last 18 holes played, followed by best nett score for the second 9 holes on that card, followed by the last 6 holes, 3 holes, last hole, then holes back until a winner is determined.
6. **Disputes:** If a player has a dispute or a complaint relating to any incident which occurs during the HMB Open, the facts of the incident must be brought to the attention of the Match and Tournament Committee as soon as practical after the incident has occurred and bearing in mind the Rules of Golf. After initial consideration and at its discretion, the Match and Tournament Committee may require the complaint to be made in writing.
7. **Pace of Play:** Your position in the field is behind the group in front of you, not in front of the group behind. Any group deemed to be slowing the field will be given an official warning, and any groups not complying with the pace of play policy may be penalised accordingly. Marshals will be out on course.
8. Any matter not mentioned is at the discretion of the Match & Tournament Championship Committee.
9. Refunds of fees for players who withdraw will be at the discretion of the Match & Tournament Committee.
